The regular meeting of the Gregory County Commission was held Tuesday, July 2, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in Burke with the following members present: Myron Johnson, Jeff Johnson, Jessy Biggins, Kelsea Sutton, and Bob Hausmann. Also present: Julie Bartling, Gregory County Auditor.

The meeting was opened and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Kelsea Sutton, second by Jeff Johnson to approve the agenda with the following additions: Courthouse repair discussion and Sheriff's Department needs. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.
