The regular meeting of the Gregory County Commission was held Tuesday, February 2, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in Burke with the following members present: Jeff Johnson, Myron Johnson, Jessy Biggins, and Lance Matucha. Also, present: Julie Bartling, Gregory County Auditor.

The meeting was opened and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Jessy Biggins, second by Lance Matucha to approve the agenda as presented. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Myron Johnson, second by Jessy Biggins to approve the minutes of the January 19, 2021 meetings as read. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Conflicts of Interest: The Chair asked if there were any conflicts of interest from members present. None were notated.

Courthouse Roof Replacement: Motion by Myron Johnson, second by Jessy Biggins to advertise for bids for replacement of the Courthouse roof, to be opened March 2, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Personnel Discussion: The Commission visited about employee salaries and made the determination that pay raises and adjustments to salaries would only be budgeted for during the annual budget process and authorized at the first meeting of each year.
