Gregory County Commission Proceedings

The regular meeting of the Gregory County Commission was held Wednesday, May 1, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in Burke with the following members present: Byrain Boes, Doug Janousek, Lance Matucha and Jeff Johnson. Members absent: Jessy Biggins. Also present: Julie Bartling, Gregory County Auditor and Patty Connealy, Gregory Times Advocate.

Vice-Chair Byrain Boes called the meeting to order and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Lance Matucha, second by Doug Janousek to approve the agenda as presented. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Doug Janousek, second by Lance Matucha to approve the minutes of the April 17, 2024 meeting as read. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Conflicts of Interest: The Vice-Chair asked if there were any conflicts of interest from members present. None were notated.

Ex-Parte Communications: The Vice-Chair inquired if there have been any ex-parte communications by any member present. None were notated.

Public Input: The Commission Vice-Chair opened the floor for public input. Steve McCance and Garry Wetzler met with the Board and handed out hand-count information and a slate of questions they would like answered surrounding the post election audit procedures. Mr. McCance has scheduled to be on the Commission agenda for the May 15, 2024 meeting.

Highway Department Report: Tyler Plumbtree, Highway Superintendent, reported on activities on going at the Highway Department.

The Highway Superintendent requested the following clarifications from the Board:

- 1) Gravel Hauling fees will not be averaged.
- 2) There will be no milling of county asphalt roads this year.
- 3) Single-family homes may be taken in at the landfill site (no concerns about asbestos), per state regulations.
- 4) The landfill will be closed May 25, 2024 in observance of Memorial Day.
- 5) The county crew will receive blade training in July from a private firm to assist the crew in adequate blading procedures.
- 6) The Board wants GPS trackers on the county blades to follow maintenance progress and to look into parking the equipment in secure locations overnight, utilizing pickups rather than driving the blades in every night.
- 7) The Board wants the roads prepared to be ready for gravel when it's hauled and spread on the roads. Hauling will begin as soon as the weather permits.
- 8) The Board wants to see quotes of a new payloader to submit with the USDA Rural Development Community grant/loan application.
- 9) The Board asked that trouble spots for gravel be taken care of ASAP.

Salary Increase Approval: Motion by Jeff Johnson, second by Doug Janousek to approve a \$.20 per hour salary increase to Hayden Hay effective May 11, 2024 as he has completed his probationary period. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Blade Operator Opening: Motion by Doug Janousek, second by Jeff Johnson to approve advertising for a blade operator at a wage to be determined by experience. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Funeral Expense Request: Motion by Jeff Johnson, second by Doug Janousek to approve an application for a burial expense for a county resident who had no resources. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.
